

# SENATE BILL NO. 607

July 27, 2021, Introduced by Senators HOLLIER, HERTEL, MOSS, GEISS, BRINKS, ANANICH, WOJNO, BAYER, CHANG, MCMORROW and POLEHANKI and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding sections 483b and 957a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           **Sec. 483b. (1) An individual employed to circulate a petition**  
2           **described in section 482 must not be paid a fixed rate or amount**  
3           **for each petition signature collected or for each completed**  
4           **petition signature sheet.**

1           (2) If an individual receives compensation to circulate a  
2 petition described in section 482, then the individual must be  
3 compensated at an hourly rate for time worked.

4           Sec. 957a. (1) An individual employed to circulate a recall  
5 petition under this chapter must not be paid a fixed rate or amount  
6 for each recall petition signature collected or for each completed  
7 recall petition signature sheet.

8           (2) If an individual receives compensation to circulate a  
9 recall petition under this chapter, then the individual must be  
10 compensated at an hourly rate for time worked.
