## **SENATE BILL NO. 751**

November 30, 2021, Introduced by Senators GEISS, IRWIN, SANTANA, WOJNO, BAYER, BRINKS, POLEHANKI, ALEXANDER, BULLOCK, MOSS, HOLLIER and CHANG and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to prescribe the powers and duties of certain water utilities; and to prescribe civil sanctions for certain violations of this act.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "water utility" means a person
- 2 that provides water supply service or sewerage service.
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) By February 1, 2022, a water utility shall prepare
- 4 a plan that does both of the following:
- 5 (a) Ensures that each permanently installed water pump or

- 2 switches to an alternative power source if the primary source of

- 4 (b) Ensures that an alternative power source under subdivision
- 5 (a) is able to operate continuously for at least 72 hours.
- 6 (2) By October 1, 2023, each water utility shall fully
- 7 implement the plan prepared in subsection (1).
- 8 Sec. 3. A water utility that violates this section is subject
- 9 to a civil fine of \$1,000.00 per day for each violation of this
