December 07, 2021, Introduced by Senator THEIS and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
by amending section 16a of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16a), as amended
by 2010 PA 97.
