THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "prohibition of COVID-19 vaccination passports by political
- 3 subdivisions act".
- 4 Sec. 3. As used in this act, "political subdivision" means a
- 5 unit of local government as defined in section 33 of article IX of
- 6 the state constitution of 1963.

- 1 Sec. 5. Except as otherwise authorized or required by a law of
- 2 the United States or this state, a political subdivision shall not
- 3 require an individual to present documentation disclosing his or
- 4 her COVID-19 vaccination or immunity status to gain access to
- 5 property owned by a political subdivision or to receive a service
- 6 from the political subdivision.
- 7 Sec. 7. (1) An individual may bring a civil action against a
- 8 political subdivision that violates this act to recover damages as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (a) If there is no previous judgment for a violation of this
- 11 act against the political subdivision, \$1,000.00.
- 12 (b) If there is 1 previous judgment for a violation of this
- 13 act against the political subdivision, \$10,000.00.
- 14 (c) If there are 2 previous judgments for a violation of this
- 15 act against the political subdivision, \$100,000.00.
- 16 (d) If there are 3 or more previous judgments for a violation
- 17 of this act against the political subdivision, \$1,000,000.00.
- 18 (2) In an action under subsection (1), the court shall award
- 19 an individual who prevails against a political subdivision actual,
- 20 reasonable attorney fees.
