June 29, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Rogers, Kahle, Puri, Cambensy, Brixie, Scott, O'Neal, Hood, Hope, Sneller, Weiss, Bezotte, Bolden, Aiyash, Brabec, Neeley, Sowerby, Steckloff, Slagh, Morse, Hertel and Camilleri and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"

Sec. 12e. This chapter applies to the following felonies
