A bill to amend 1982 PA 540, entitled "Library of Michigan act,"

(MCL 397.11 to 397.24) by amending the title, as amended by 2001 PA 62, and by adding sections 3a and 12a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to create the library of Michigan; to create a board of trustees for the library; to establish the qualifications of the state librarian; to provide the powers and duties of the board of
