THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7b. (1) The following items shall must meet the
- 2 appropriate requirements for resistance to fire prescribed in the
- 3 standard methods of fire tests for flame-resistant textiles, films,
- 4 national fire protection association No. 701-1969:CPAI-84 (2021), A
- 5 Specification for Flame-Resistant Materials Used in Camping
- 6 Tentage, and all revisions to that standard adopted in rules

- 1 promulgated by the director, or another nationally recognized
- 2 standard that is acceptable to the director as set forth in rules
- 3 promulgated by the director:
- 4 (a) A tent which that may be occupied or furnished for public
- 5 assembly by 50 or more people.
- 6 (b) A tent in which animals are stabled for public exhibition7 or sale.
- 8 (c) A tent located within a building used by the public.
- 9 (d) All tarpaulins and decorative material used in connection10 with any of the above.
- (2) A safety net or tent used for recreational camping isexempt from this section.
- (3) After October 1, 1975, all camping tentage of new
- 14 manufacture sold in this state shall comply with the provisions for
- 15 resistance to fire as prescribed in the specification for flame-
- 16 resistant materials used in camping tentage, canvas products
- 17 association international-84, 1974, or another nationally
- 18 recognized standard that is acceptable to the director.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 20 after the date it is enacted into law.
