

# HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 325

Reps. Pepper, Bezotte, Breen, Tyrone Carter, Haadsma, Harris, Hertel, Hope, Kuppa, Liberati, Morse, Sneller, Steenland, Thanedar, Weiss, Witwer and Young offered the following resolution:

1           A resolution to declare July 24, 2022, as Law Enforcement  
2 Spouses Day in the state of Michigan.

5           Whereas, Spouses of law enforcement officers are unsung heroes  
6 on duty 7 days a week, 24 hours a day caring for their families,  
7 always prepared for unexpected changes; and

10 guaranteed a partner to return from the line of duty; and

1           Whereas, Spouses of law enforcement officers make innumerable  
2 selfless personal sacrifices to support their partners and family;

5 support and care for their partners through the immense mental and  
6 physical challenges of the profession; and

7           Whereas, Spouses of law enforcement officers in every  
8 community around the state of Michigan play an integral role in the

11 challenges and duties with grace and dignity, even in the most  
12 difficult times; and

13           Whereas, Spouses of law enforcement officers display shining  
14 examples of love, commitment, partnership, and service to our  
15 state; now, therefore, be it
