- 1 A resolution to declare September 15-October 15, 2022, as
- 2 Hispanic Heritage Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, There has been a long and important presence of
- 4 Hispanic and Latino Americans in North America and the United
- 5 States of America; and
- 6 Whereas, The month of September 15 to October 15 represents
- 7 the anniversary of independence for Chile, Costa Rica, El Salvador,
- 8 Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, and Nicaragua; and
- 9 Whereas, Each year, Americans observe National Hispanic
- 10 Heritage Month from September 15 to October 15 by celebrating the

- 1 histories, cultures, and contributions of American citizens whose
- 2 ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Central and
- 3 South America; and
- 4 Whereas, Each year, the United States recognizes the economic,
- 5 cultural, and social contributions that Spanish-speaking peoples
- 6 have brought to our nation, including the gifts of law, religion,
- 7 agriculture, art, music, education, technology, architecture,
- 8 cuisine, theater, and exploration; and
- 9 Whereas, Time and again throughout our nation's history,
- 10 Hispanic-Americans have faithfully defended the principles of
- 11 freedom and a representative government; and
- 12 Whereas, Hispanic Heritage Week was approved by President
- 13 Lyndon Johnson and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988
- 14 to cover a 30-day period from September 15 to October 15, and
- 15 enacted into law on August 17, 1988, as Public Law 100-402; and
- 16 Whereas, This state is fortunate to count among its population
- 17 a large concentration of citizens of Spanish and Latin American
- 18 descent, including those who have lived in this state for
- 19 generations and those who are new to this state, who contribute to
- 20 our economy and society through their commitment to professions,
- 21 commerce, family, and the arts; and
- Whereas, During the month from September 15 to October 15,
- 23 this state's Hispanic American community celebrates Hispanic
- 24 Heritage Month through a series of special programs featuring
- 25 Hispanic history, food, dance, and art; and
- 26 Whereas, National Hispanic Heritage Month is the period of
- 27 time in the United States when people recognize the contributions
- 28 of Hispanic and Latino Americans to the United States and celebrate
- 29 these people's varied heritage, background, and culture; now,

- 2 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 3 this legislative body declare September 15-October 15, 2022, as
- 4 Hispanic Heritage Month in the state of Michigan. We recognize and
- 5 celebrate the contributions, service, and cultures of American
- 6 citizens whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean,
- 7 and Central and South America.
