- 6 Whereas, Many children and adolescents face serious challenges
- 7 to their mental health; and
- 8 Whereas, The mental health of children and adolescents
- 9 substantially impacts their future quality of life and ability to

- 1 contribute to society as adults; and
- 2 Whereas, Preventative measures, early identification, and
- 3 early interventions for the mental health of children and
- 4 adolescents are proven to be highly cost-effective and efficient
- 5 measures that maximize their health status; and
- 6 Whereas, The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services,
- 7 the Association for Children's Mental Health, Michigan behavioral
- 8 health care providers, quality improvement partners, and behavioral
- 9 health advocates as well as the children and youth with lived
- 10 experience, and their families through their unique approach and
- 11 expertise in serving children and adolescents, are effectively
- 12 caring for the mental health needs of children, youth, and families
- in our community; and
- 14 Whereas, It is appropriate that a day should be set apart each
- 15 year for the direction of our thoughts toward our children's mental
- 16 health and well-being; and
- 17 Whereas, This resolution calls attention to the importance of
- 18 children's mental health and well-being and observance of the
- 19 annual National Children's Mental Health Awareness Day on May 7;
- 20 now, therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 22 this legislative body declare May 7, 2021, as Children's Mental
- 23 Health Awareness Day in the state of Michigan.
