HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.63

Rep. Alexander offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare March 23, 2021, as Agriculture Day in the state of Michigan. 2 3 Whereas, Each year, states across the nation recognize March as a time to celebrate the importance of food and agriculture as a 4 significant contributor to the national economy; and 5 6 Whereas, The Michigan food and agriculture industry 7 contributes more than \$104.7 billion annually to the state's 8 economy. It is a major source of employment for the state's workforce, supporting approximately 805,000 jobs and roughly 17.2 9 percent of the state's workforce; and 10 Whereas, Michigan's food and agriculture sector are the second 11 12 most diverse in the country with nearly 47,000 farms, 99 percent of which are family-owned, farming nearly 10 million acres of 13

- 1 farmland, and commercially producing more than 300 food and
- 2 agricultural commodities. The state is the largest producer of
- 3 asparagus, cucumbers, squash, and many bedding plants grown in
- 4 greenhouses, and ranks in the top ten for 29 additional
- 5 commodities, including apples, blueberries, and cherries; and
- 6 Whereas, Michigan greenhouses and nurseries rank 3rd
- 7 nationally in overall economic impact of plant production.
- 8 Greenhouses are the 4th largest segment of Michigan's agriculture
- 9 economy. Greenhouse and nursery products generate 14% of Michigan's
- 10 total agricultural revenues. Michigan greenhouse production boast
- 11 first in production of many bedding plants including petunias,
- 12 geraniums, and impatiens; and
- 13 Whereas, Twenty-four percent of Michigan's agricultural
- 14 revenues are generated by dairy products, most notably, milk, and
- 15 cheese; and
- 16 Whereas, Michigan exports about one-third of its agricultural
- 17 commodities each year, generating nearly \$2 billion. Almost 40
- 18 percent of Michigan's agricultural exports go directly to Canada,
- 19 our number one export market, and rounding out the top countries
- 20 eager for Michigan-grown products are Mexico, Japan, South Korea
- 21 and China; and
- 22 Whereas, Michigan's food and agricultural sector continues to
- 23 be a growing industry offering new business and career
- 24 opportunities for Michiganders, making food and agriculture a
- 25 cornerstone of Michigan's continued prosperity; and
- 26 Resolved by the House of the Representatives, That the members
- 27 of this legislative body declare March 23, 2021, as Agriculture Day
- 28 in the state of Michigan. We encourage all citizens to recognize
- 29 and celebrate this momentous occasion.
