Reps. Bolden and Anthony offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare January 15, 2022, as Alpha Kappa Alpha 2 Sorority, Incorporated Founders' Day in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, is the oldest Greek-lettered organization to have been established by 4 African-American college-educated women; and 5 6 Whereas, Alpha Kappa Alpha was founded at Howard University in 7 Washington, D.C. in 1908; and Whereas, Founder Ethel Hedgeman Lyle envisioned the sorority 8 9 as an instrument for enriching campus life by promoting unity and cultivating high academic and ethical standards; and 10 Whereas, Through the years, the sorority's function has become 11 12 more complex, branching out to engage members worldwide in advocacy 13 and service projects to improve socioeconomic, racial, political,

- 2 Whereas, Alpha Kappa Alpha's diverse, collaborative work
- 3 throughout the United States, the Caribbean, Europe, Africa, and
- 4 United Arab Emirates integrates a high level of personal engagement
- 5 with the strong bonds of sisterhood and a productive network of
- 6 community partners; and
- 7 Whereas, Michigan hosts over 30 Alpha Kappa Alpha chapters
- 8 which are located on college and university campuses and have
- 9 active alumnae groups in communities throughout the state; and
- 10 Whereas, The Great Lakes Region is home to 97 empowered and
- 11 engaged chapters serving Michigan, Ohio, western New York, western
- 12 Pennsylvania, and West Virginia; and
- 13 Whereas, There are two members of Alpha Kappa Alpha currently
- 14 serving in the 101st Michigan Legislature, now, therefore, be it
- 15 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 16 this legislative body declare January 15, 2022, as Alpha Kappa
- 17 Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, Founders' Day in the state of
- 18 Michigan; and be it further
- 19 Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 20 Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Pi Tau Omega and Delta Tau Omega
- 21 Chapters in recognition of all Michigan chapters.
