

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 314

Reps. Sneller, Ellison, O'Neal, Scott, Rabhi, Koleszar, Hope, Neeley, Brabec, Glanville, Cavanagh, Lasinski, Puri, Camilleri, Hood, Sowerby, Manoogian, Morse, Tyrone Carter, Young, Rogers and Pohutsky offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to recognize June 2022 as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual,
2 Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ) Pride Month in the state of
3 Michigan.

4 Whereas, Pride began 52 years ago in 1970 with the one year
5 anniversary of the Stonewall Riots. In 1969, a black trans woman
6 named Marsha P. Johnson, along with other LGBTQ individuals, risked
7 their lives to protest the over-policing of the LGBTQ community and
8 the injustice that threatened their existence on a daily basis.
9 This multi-day protest became known as the Stonewall Riots and is
10 credited by many for starting the modern-day LGBTQ equality

1 movement; and

2 Whereas, The LGBTQ movement has endured through tragedy and
3 struggle, including the slow and insufficient government response
4 to assist those with HIV/AIDS and the ongoing effort today to
5 protect the rights of the LGBTQ community; and

6 Whereas, The movement has also celebrated victories of
7 recognition, especially the historic *Obergefell v. Hodges* decision
8 in 2015 which affirmed marriage equality nationwide and the recent
9 *Bostock v. Clayton County* decision in 2020 that upheld federal
10 employment protections for the LGBTQ community; and

11 Whereas, Everyone in Michigan benefits from the multiple
12 talents, viewpoints, and cultural backgrounds of all of its
13 residents and from preserving the freedom, worth, and dignity of
14 those in the LGBTQ community; and

15 Whereas, Michigan should expend all efforts to attract and
16 retain talent and signal to the nation we are welcoming to all
17 those who wish to contribute to the economic vitality of our state;
18 and

19 Whereas, The people of Michigan understand, appreciate, and
20 value the cultural, civic, and economic contributions of the LGBTQ
21 communities to the greater community of the state, and affirm a
22 celebration of love, living authentically, and accepting ourselves;

24 Whereas, June is recognized and celebrated as LGBTQ Pride
25 Month throughout the country and worldwide; now, therefore, be it

26 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
27 this legislative body recognize June 2022 as Lesbian, Gay,
28 Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ) Pride Month in the state
29 of Michigan.
