## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.336

Rep. Thanedar offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to condemn the Supreme Court of the United

2 States' decision to overturn Roe v. Wade and Planned Parenthood v.

3 Casey and to commit to advancing reproductive justice.

4 Whereas, Approximately 64,000,000 women and girls of

5 reproductive age live in the United States. Lack of access to safe,

6 affordable, timely, and respectful abortion care poses risks to

their physical and mental well-being across their lifetime; and

Whereas, In Roe v. Wade, the United States Supreme Court

affirmed the right to choose to bear a child and maintain bodily

10 autonomy. This ability to choose allows women to participate

11 equally in the economic and social life of the United States. The

12 Court further affirmed these rights in Planned Parenthood v. Casey;

Whereas, In Dobbs v. Jackson, the Supreme Court held that the 1 United States Constitution does not confer a right to an abortion -2 overruling Roe and Casev. Instead, the ruling returned the 3 authority to regulate abortion to states. With this ruling, the 4 5 Supreme Court says that, from the very moment of fertilization, a 6 woman has no rights to speak of. This decision blatantly disregards 7 women's rights to bodily autonomy and allows states to force women 8 to carry pregnancies to term, despite the risks and costs; and 9 Whereas, Immediately following the Dobbs decision, states 10 began to rip away the reproductive rights that women have held for 11 nearly half a century. Some states have passed laws without any 12 exceptions for victims of sexual assault, without regard for the 13 mother's life, and without any plan on helping mothers take care of 14 the babies that are the result of forced pregnancy. Some states 15 have even begun to consider criminal penalties for what should be 16 considered a private medical decision; and 17 Whereas, Not only has the Supreme Court undermined the rights 18 of women across the country, it has blatantly ignored court precedent, and has threatened a number of other constitutional 19 20 rights. Recent polls found that public confidence in the Supreme Court is at an all-time low of 25 percent. As the Court continues 21 to be nothing more than an extension of political ideals, our most 22 23 vulnerable are more at risk of losing their rights than ever; and Whereas, Undocumented women, women living in poverty, and 24 25 women who are members of marginalized groups will face the most risks as a result of the Supreme Court's actions. We commit to 26 27 advancing state law to protect the reproductive rights of women across the state. We commit to communities that will be 28 29 disproportionately impacted by the destructive holding of Dobbs;
