

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.394

Rep. Beeler offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare December 2, 2022, as Children of
2 Abraham Day in the state of Michigan.

3 Whereas, The United States is a tapestry comprising all
4 religious faiths, predominant among them are Judaism, Christianity,
5 and Islam; and

6 Whereas, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam have a shared
7 connection to Abraham and recognize this historical connection; and

8 Whereas, As followers of these faiths, they practice their
9 faith and are called to embrace a spirit of religious toleration as
10 Americans; and

11 Whereas, The freedom of religion is enshrined as an
12 inseparable cornerstone of American government and public life that
13 guarantees the right of religious expression; and

1 Whereas, This religious toleration is exemplary not only of
2 their shared heritage in faith but also their patriotism; and

3 Whereas, Recognizing the importance of religious expression, a
4 shared heritage, and a patriotic spirit of toleration; now,
5 therefore, be it

6 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
7 this legislative body declare December 2, 2022, as Children of
8 Abraham day in the state of Michigan.
