## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.146

Rep. VanWoerkom offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare August 8-14, 2021, as Community Health 2 Center Week in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, For over 50 years, Community health centers have provided high-quality, affordable, comprehensive primary and 4 preventive health care in our nation's underserved communities, 5 delivering value to and having a significant impact on America's 6 7 health care system; and 8 Whereas, As the country's largest primary care network, community health centers are the health care home for 30 million 9 Americans in over 134,000 communities across the nation. One in 10 every twelve people in the United States gets their care in a 11 12 community health center; and

Whereas, Community health centers are a critical element of 1 the health system, serving both rural and urban communities, and 2 often providing the only accessible and dependable source of 3 primary care in their communities. Nationwide, community health 4 5 centers serve one in every five residents of rural areas; and 6 Whereas, Community health centers serve as beacons of 7 essential resources and support in testing and treatment in the 8 face of the global coronavirus pandemic and will continue to offer 9 reliable, affordable, high-quality care against COVID-19 for 10 America's most vulnerable and underserved communities; and 11 Whereas, Every day, community health centers develop new approaches to integrating a wide range of services beyond primary 12 care, including oral health, vision, behavioral health, and 13 14 pharmacy services, to meet the needs and challenges of their 15 communities; and 16 Whereas, Community health centers are governed by patientmajority boards, ensuring that the patients of each health center 17 18 are engaged in their own health care decisions; 19 Whereas, Community health centers are locally owned and 20 operated small businesses that serve as critical economic engines, helping to power local economies by generating \$63,454.6 billion in 21 economic activity in some of the country's most economically-22 23 deprived communities; and 24 Whereas, Community health centers nationally employ more than 25 2,503,000 people, including physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and certified nurse midwives who work as part 26 27 of multi-disciplinary clinical teams designed to treat the whole 28 patient; and

Whereas, The community health center model continues to prove

an effective means of overcoming barriers to healthcare access, 1 including geography, income and insurance status - improving health 2 care outcomes and reducing health care system costs; and 3 Whereas, Community health centers reduce overall costs of care 4 5 by helping manage patients' chronic conditions, which keeps them 6 out of costlier health care settings like hospital emergency rooms; 7 Whereas, Community health centers are on the front lines of 8 emerging health care crises, providing access to care for our nation's veterans, addressing the opioid epidemic, and responding 9 10 to public health threats in the wake of natural disasters; and 11 Whereas, National Health Center Week offers the opportunity to celebrate America's over 1,400 health center organizations with 12 over 132,000 service delivery sites, their dedicated staff, board 13 14 members, patients and all those responsible for their continued 15 success and growth since the first health centers opened their 16 doors more than 50 years ago; and 17 Whereas, During National Health Center Week, we celebrate the 18 legacy of America's community health centers, and their vital role 19 in shaping the past, present, and future of America's health care 20 system; now, therefore, be it Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 21 22 this legislative body declare August 8-14, 2021, as Community 23 Health Center Week in the state of Michigan. We encourage all 24 Americans to take part in this week by visiting their local health 25 center and celebrating the important partnership between America's

community health centers and the communities they serve.
