SENATE RESOLUTION NO.67

Senators Bumstead, Theis, Nesbitt, Lauwers and Zorn offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to oppose the suspension of all oil and gas
- 2 leases in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge.
- 3 Whereas, The Arctic National Wildlife Refuge (ANWR) in Alaska
- 4 is believed to contain up to 11 billion barrels of oil. In 2017,
- 5 Congress approved legislation to open the federal lands on ANWR to
- 6 energy development. The law established an oil and gas program and
- 7 required at least two area-wide lease sales in the ANWR's Coastal
- 8 Plain by the end of 2024; and
- 9 Whereas, The development of the ANWR's oil and gas resources
- 10 will further American energy independence and security. The Energy
- 11 Information Administration estimates that crude oil imports will
- 12 decline by one barrel for every barrel of ANWR oil production; and

- 1 Whereas, The federal government will benefit from new revenue
- 2 generated from lease sales, royalties, and taxes for the life of
- 3 the ANWR field production. Some estimates show new revenue could be
- 4 as much as \$296 billion; and
- 5 Whereas, Energy production in the ANWR's Coastal Region will
- 6 be good for the local economy, generating approximately 55,000 to
- 7 130,000 jobs. The development has support from the only village
- 8 inside the ANWR's boundary; and
- 9 Whereas, On June 1, 2021, President Biden announced the
- 10 suspension of oil and gas leases in the ANWR, threatening American
- 11 energy independence, federal revenue, and good-paying jobs; now,
- 12 therefore, be it
- 13 Resolved by the Senate, That we oppose the suspension of all
- 14 oil and gas leases in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge; and be
- 15 it further
- 16 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 17 President Biden and the Secretary of the U.S. Department of the
- 18 Interior.
