

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 1108**

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding sections 483b, 544g, 590i, and
957a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **Sec. 483b. (1) An individual employed to circulate a petition**
2 **described in section 482 must not be paid a fixed rate or amount**
3 **for each petition signature collected or for each completed**
4 **petition signature sheet.**

5 **(2) If an individual receives compensation to circulate a**
6 **petition described in section 482, then the individual must be**
7 **compensated at an hourly rate for time worked.**

8 **Sec. 544g. (1) An individual employed to circulate a**



1 nominating petition must not be paid a fixed rate or amount for
2 each nominating petition signature collected or for each completed
3 nominating petition signature sheet.

4 (2) If an individual receives compensation to circulate a
5 nominating petition, then the individual must be compensated at an
6 hourly rate for time worked.

7 Sec. 590i. (1) An individual employed to circulate a
8 qualifying petition must not be paid a fixed rate or amount for
9 each qualifying petition signature collected or for each completed
10 qualifying petition signature sheet.

11 (2) If an individual receives compensation to circulate a
12 qualifying petition, then the individual must be compensated at an
13 hourly rate for time worked.

14 Sec. 957a. (1) An individual employed to circulate a recall
15 petition under this chapter must not be paid a fixed rate or amount
16 for each recall petition signature collected or for each completed
17 recall petition signature sheet.

18 (2) If an individual receives compensation to circulate a
19 recall petition under this chapter, then the individual must be
20 compensated at an hourly rate for time worked.
