A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled
"Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"
by amending section 205a (MCL 37.2205a), as amended by 1999 PA 202.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 205a. (1) An employer, employment agency, or labor
2 organization, ~~other than~~ **not including** a law enforcement agency of
3 this state or **of** a political subdivision of this state, shall not,
4 in connection with an application for employment or membership ~~or~~

1 in connection with the terms, conditions, or privileges of
2 employment or membership, request, make, or maintain a record of
3 information regarding ~~a~~**any of the following:**

4 (a) A misdemeanor arrest, detention, or disposition where a
5 conviction did not result. ~~A person is not guilty of perjury or~~
6 ~~otherwise for giving~~

7 (b) A conviction set aside under 1965 PA 213, MCL 780.621 to
8 780.624.

9 (c) The placement of an individual on probation under section
10 1(1) of chapter XI of the code of criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175,
11 MCL 771.1.

12 (d) A criminal disposition under chapter XIIA of the probate
13 code of 1939, 1939 PA 288, MCL 712A.1 to 712A.32.

14 (e) An individual's status as a youthful trainee under section
15 11 of chapter II of the code of criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175,
16 MCL 762.11.

17 (2) An individual who gives a ~~false~~ statement ~~by failing to~~
18 **that does not** recite or acknowledge information the ~~person~~
19 **individual** has a civil right to withhold ~~by~~**under** this section **is**
20 **not guilty of perjury or otherwise**. This section does not apply to
21 information ~~relative to~~**regarding** a felony charge before conviction
22 or dismissal.

23 (3) ~~(2)~~As used in this section, "law enforcement agency"
24 includes the ~~state~~ department of corrections.
