

HOUSE BILL NO. 4685

May 25, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Friske, Rigas, DeSana, Fox, Carra, Alexander, Maddock and Cavitt and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 14b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 14b. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
2 person who advertises, publishes, sells, or publicly exposes for
3 sale any pills, powder, drugs, or combination of drugs, designed
4 expressly for the purpose of procuring an abortion, is guilty of a
5 misdemeanor.

6 (2) Any drug or medicine known to be designed and expressly
7 prepared for producing an abortion may only be sold upon the

1 written prescription of an established practicing physician of the
2 city, village, or township in which the sale is made, and the
3 pharmacist or retailer selling the drug or medicine shall, in a
4 book provided for that purpose, register the name of the purchaser,
5 the date of the sale, the kind and quantity of the medicine sold,
6 and the name and residence of the physician prescribing the drug or
7 medicine.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
9 after the date it is enacted into law.

10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
11 unless Senate Joint Resolution _____ or House Joint Resolution C
12 (request no. 03057'23) of the 102nd Legislature becomes a part of
13 the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of article
14 XII of the state constitution of 1963.
