THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 33a. (1) Subject to subsection (2), not later than July 1 of each odd numbered year, the secretary of state shall post on the department of state website the name of each county, city, and township clerk who is not current with the clerk's continuing

election education training as required under section 33. The
