## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 706. (1) Except as allowed under this section, a settlement agreement relating to a claim described in subsection (2) must not contain a provision that prevents or restricts the disclosure of factual information related to the claim.
- 5 (2) This section applies to a claim of assault,

- 1 discrimination, harassment, or retaliation because of sex against
- 2 an employer made in a complaint to the department as described in
- 3 section 602 or in a civil action under article 8.
- 4 (3) In a civil action described in subsection (2), the court
- 5 shall not enter, by stipulation or otherwise, an order that
- 6 restricts the disclosure of information in a manner that conflicts
- 7 with subsection (1).
- 8 (4) A provision that shields the identity of the claimant and
- 9 all facts that could lead to the discovery of the claimant's
- 10 identity, including pleadings filed in court, may be included in a
- 11 settlement agreement at the request of the claimant. This
- 12 subsection does not apply if a government agency or public official
- 13 is a party to the settlement agreement.
- 14 (5) A provision that precludes the disclosure of the amount
- 15 paid in settlement of the claim may be included in a settlement
- 16 agreement.
- 17 (6) A provision in a settlement agreement that is prohibited
- 18 by subsection (1) is void as a matter of law and against public
- 19 policy.
