10 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

## **GENERAL SECTIONS**

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024 is \$250,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

## DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for pathogen enhancement engineering or research whistleblower reward must be used by the department to provide rewards to individuals who report persons illegally conducting pathogen enhancement engineering or research, as described in section 2670 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2670.

- (2) Unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for pathogen enhancement engineering or research whistleblower reward are designated as a work project appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for expenditures for projects under this section until the projects have been completed. The following is in compliance with section 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
- (a) The purpose of the project is to provide rewards to individuals who report persons illegally conducting pathogen enhancement engineering or research, as described in section 2670 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2670.
- (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state employees or contracts with service providers, or both.
  - (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$250,000.00.
  - (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2028.
