## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5409**

January 23, 2024, Introduced by Reps. Bruck, Maddock, Alexander, Johnsen, Kunse, Fox and Wozniak and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to provide a system for reviewing case files or reinvestigations of certain cold case homicides; to adopt certain policies; to require the promulgation of rules; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "homicide victim's family
   rights act".
- 3 Sec. 3. This act applies to a cold case homicide that occurred 4 on or after January 1, 1970.

- 1 Sec. 5. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Case file review" means the review of a cold case
- 3 homicide file.
- 4 (b) "Cold case homicide" means a homicide that meets all of
- 5 the following conditions:
- 6 (i) Was committed more than 3 years before the date a
- 7 designated person made an application under section 9.
- 8 (ii) Was previously investigated by a law enforcement agency.
- 9 (iii) All probative investigative leads have been exhausted.
- (iv) No likely perpetrator has been identified.
- 11 (c) "Designated person" means an immediate family member of
- 12 the victim or a legal representative of the immediate family member
- 13 of the victim.
- 14 (d) "Homicide" means any crime in which the death of a human
- 15 being is an element of that crime.
- 16 (e) "Immediate family member" means a parent, parent-in-law,
- 17 grandparent, grandparent-in-law, sibling, spouse, child, or
- 18 stepchild of a victim.
- 19 (f) "Law enforcement agency" means any of the following:
- 20 (i) The department of state police.
- (ii) A local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction to
- 22 engage in the detection, investigation, or prosecution of a cold
- 23 case homicide.
- 24 (q) "Probative investigative leads" means evidence that is
- 25 sufficiently useful to prove an element of the crime and was not
- 26 identified or determined as part of the previous investigation by a
- 27 law enforcement agency.
- (h) "Victim" means a natural person who died as a result of a
- 29 cold case homicide.

- 1 Sec. 7. No later than 90 days after the effective date of this 2 act, a law enforcement agency shall do all of the following:
- 3 (a) Promulgate rules to ensure compliance with this act.
- 4 (b) Develop a written application to be used by a designated5 person to request a case file review under this act.
- 6 (c) Adopt a written policy to ensure compliance with this act.
- 7 A written policy adopted under this act must include, but is not
- 8 limited to, all of the following:
- 9 (i) The process to designate an administrative authority or a
  10 person within the law enforcement agency to receive and investigate
  11 complaints relating to a case file review or reinvestigation of a
  12 cold case homicide under this act.
- (ii) Disciplinary sanctions for employees of the lawenforcement agency that violate this act.
- 15 (iii) Procedures for the resolution of a complaint filed by a
  16 designated person concerning the law enforcement agency's handling
  17 of a case file review or reinvestigation of a cold case homicide
  18 under this act.
- Sec. 9. (1) No later than 14 business days after a written application by a designated person, a law enforcement agency shall conduct a case file review to determine if a full reinvestigation of a cold case homicide would result in either the identification of probative investigative leads or a likely perpetrator. Only 1 case file review must be undertaken at any time with respect to the same cold case homicide victim.
- 26 (2) A case file review conducted under subsection (1) must 27 include all of the following:
- (a) An analysis of what investigative steps or follow-up stepsmay have been missed in the initial investigation.

- (b) An assessment of whether witnesses should be interviewed
   or reinterviewed.
- 3 (c) An examination of physical evidence to see if all
  4 appropriate forensic testing and analysis was performed in the
  5 first instance or if additional testing might produce information
  6 relevant to the investigation.
- 7 (d) An update of the case file using the most current
  8 investigative standards as of the date of the review to the extent
  9 it would help develop probative investigative leads.
- 10 (3) An individual who previously investigated the cold case
  11 homicide at issue shall not conduct a case file review under this
  12 section.
- 13 Sec. 11. (1) If, after conducting a case file review under 14 section 9, a law enforcement agency determines that a full 15 reinvestigation of the cold case homicide is not warranted, the law 16 enforcement agency shall, as soon as practicable, issue a written certification to the designated person that submitted the 17 application for the case file review. The written certification 18 issued under this subsection must state that a full reinvestigation 19 20 is not warranted because all probative leads have been exhausted or a likely perpetrator will not be identified. If a law enforcement 21 22 agency determines that a full reinvestigation of the cold case 23 homicide is not warranted under this subsection, no additional case 24 file review for the cold case homicide must be conducted for a 25 period of 5 years unless there is newly discovered, materially 26 significant evidence.
- (2) If, after conducting a case file review under section 9, a
  law enforcement agency determines that a full reinvestigation of
  the cold case homicide is warranted, the law enforcement agency

- 1 shall reinvestigate the cold case homicide. If a full
- 2 reinvestigation of a cold case homicide is completed under this
- 3 subsection and no probative investigative leads or perpetrator is
- 4 identified at its conclusion, no additional case file review for
- 5 the cold case homicide must be conducted for a period of 5 years
- 6 unless there is newly discovered, materially significant evidence.
- 7 (3) Nothing in this act prohibits a law enforcement agency
- 8 from continuing the investigation of a cold case homicide without a
- 9 designated person's application.
- 10 (4) Nothing in this act requires a law enforcement agency to
- 11 do any of the following:
- 12 (a) Provide information that would endanger the safety of any
- 13 person or unreasonably impede an ongoing investigation.
- 14 (b) Violate a court order.
- 15 (c) Violate privacy rights.
- Sec. 13. If more than 1 law enforcement agency conduct case
- 17 file reviews or reinvestigations of a cold case homicide, the law
- 18 enforcement agencies shall coordinate their case file reviews or
- 19 reinvestigations of the cold case homicide such that there is only
- 20 1 joint case file review or reinvestigation of the cold case
- 21 homicide occurring at a time.
