A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 227 (MCL 750.227), as amended by 1986 PA 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 227. (1) A person shall not carry a dagger, dirk,

- 2 (2) A person shall not carry a pistol concealed on or about
- 3 his or her that person, or, whether concealed or otherwise, in a

- 5 that person's dwelling house, place of business, or on other land
- 6 possessed by the person, without a license to carry the pistol as
- 7 provided by law and if licensed, shall not carry the pistol in a
- 8 place or manner inconsistent with any restrictions upon such on
