## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5687**

April 25, 2024, Introduced by Reps. Wendzel, Aragona, DeBoyer, Harris, Roth, Wozniak and Bezotte and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 160d.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 160d. (1) An individual who engages in sexual contact or
- 2 sexual penetration with a dead human body is guilty of a felony
- 3 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 20 years or a fine of
- 4 not more than \$40,000.00, or both.
- 5 (2) As used in this section:
- 6 (a) "Sexual contact" includes the intentional touching of a

- 1 dead human body's or actor's intimate parts or the intentional
- 2 touching of the clothing covering the immediate area of the dead
- 3 human body's or actor's intimate parts, if that intentional
- 4 touching can reasonably be construed as being for the purpose of
- 5 sexual arousal or gratification, done for a sexual purpose, or in a
- 6 sexual manner for the following purposes:
- 7 (i) Revenge.
- 8 (ii) To inflict humiliation.
- 9 (iii) Out of anger.
- 10 (b) "Sexual penetration" means sexual intercourse,
- 11 cunnilingus, fellatio, anal intercourse, or any other intrusion,
- 12 however slight, of any part of an individual's body or of any
- 13 object into the genital or anal openings of a dead human body, but
- 14 emission of semen is not required.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 16 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 17 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act may be known as
- 18 "Melody's Law".
