- Sec. 3406pp. (1) A health insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this state must provide coverage for
- 3 the treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders
- 4 associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset
- 5 neuropsychiatric syndrome, including, but not limited to, the use
- 6 of intravenous immunoglobulin therapy.

- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 daysafter the date it is enacted into law.
- 3 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act applies to health
- 4 insurance policies delivered, executed, issued, amended, adjusted,
- 5 or renewed in this state, or outside of this state if covering
- 6 residents of this state, beginning 90 days after the date this
- 7 amendatory act is enacted into law.
