A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 234g.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 234q. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), an
- 2 individual who intentionally discharges a firearm at a motor
- 3 vehicle that he or she knows or has reason to believe is occupied
- 4 is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than
- 5 10 years or a fine of not more than \$10,000.00, or both.
- 6 (2) An individual who violates subsection (1) and who knows or

- 1 has reason to believe that the vehicle is occupied by a minor is
- 2 guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 20
- 3 years or a fine of not more than \$20,000.00, or both.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 6 Enacting section 2. This act must be known and may be cited as
- 7 "Messiah's Law".
