- 18 of not more than \$1,000.00 per day. The prosecutor of the county in

- 23 (a) "Bird" means any species of poultry.
- 24 (b) "Force-feeding" means to deliver food by placing a tube or
- 25 other device into the esophagus of a bird and includes any other
- 26 feeding method designed to cause ingestion of an amount of food by
- 27 a bird that exceeds the amount that would be ingested voluntarily.
