THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 9209. (1) Before November 1 of each year, the principal
- 2 or administrator of each school shall deliver to the state and

- 4 time of school entry of new entering kindergarten and first grade

 of immunization for children in a school.

 levels established pursuant to under subsection (2).
- 9 (b) By June 1, 2026 and by June 1 of each year thereafter,
 10 submit a written report to the local governing entity that includes
 11 all of the following:
 - (i) The immunization level of children entering school.

- 15 (iii) The percentage of children who are exempt from 16 immunization under section 9215(2).
 - (iv) A list of each school in the area serviced by the local health department with a total percentage of children who are exempt from immunization under section 9215 that exceeds 5%, and a description of the action that the local health department plans to take during the next year to reduce the total percentage of children who are exempt from immunization under section 9215 to below 5%.
 - (4) Before the following February 1, the principal or administrator of each school shall update the list **described in subsection (1)** to show the additional immunizations received by each child since entering the school. The reports shall must be made on forms provided or approved by the department. A child who enters school in September and who has not completed the

- 1 immunizations required under section 9227 and has not filed an
- 2 exemption under section 9215 before February 1 shall must be
- 3 excluded from school attendance. A child who enters school at any
- 4 other time of the school year and who has not completed the
