- 1 Sec. 4. (1). Subject to the exceptions specified in this act, 2 the minimum hourly wage rate is:
- 3 (a) a. Beginning January 1, 2019, \$10.00.2025, \$10.56.
- 4 (b) b. Beginning January 1, 2020, \$10.65. February 21, 2025,
- 5 \$12.48.
- 6 (c) e. Beginning January 1, 2021, \$11.35.2026, \$14.00.

- 1 (e) Beginning January 1, 2028, \$17.00.
- 2 (f) Beginning January 1, 2029, \$18.50.

- 4 (2) Every October beginning in October, <del>2022, 2030</del>, the state
- 5 treasurer shall calculate an adjusted minimum wage rate. The
