April 20, 2023, Introduced by Senator CHERRY and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for certain capital outlay projects for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023; to provide for expenditure of the appropriations; and to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. In accordance with section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023 is \$23,306,200.00. State appropriations paid to

1 local units of government are \$12,608,200.00 as follows:

 6 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
 7 to 18.1594.

9 **CAPITAL OUTLAY**

10 Sec. 301. (1) The department of natural resources shall enter
 11 into agreements with local units of government to administer the
 12 grants identified in part 1. Among other provisions, the agreements
 13 must require that grant recipients agree to dedicate to public
 14 outdoor recreation uses in perpetuity the land acquired or
 15 developed; to replace lands converted or lost to other than public
 16 outdoor recreation use; and, for parcels acquired that are larger
 17 than 5 acres, to provide this state with a nonparticipating 1/6
 18 minimum royalty interest in any acquired minerals that are retained
 19 by the grant recipient.

20 (2) The agreements under subsection (1) must also provide that
 21 the full payments of grants be made only after proof of
 22 acquisition, or proof of completion of the development project, is
 23 submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are verified by the
 24 department of natural resources. This requirement may be waived by
 25 the department of natural resources.

26 Sec. 302. The appropriations in part 1 for capital outlay
 27 shall be carried forward at the end of the fiscal year consistent
 28 with the provisions of section 248 of the management and budget
 29 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1248.

1 Sec. 303. (1) The state share of the following capital outlay
 2 appropriation authorized in 2020 PA 145 for Michigan natural
 3 resources trust fund projects that has since been withdrawn by the
 4 grantee is reduced up to the amount indicated and the money lapsed
 5 for the purpose of redirecting resources to Michigan natural
 6 resources trust fund projects appropriated in part 1:
