

SENATE BILL NO. 780

March 12, 2024, Introduced by Senator ALBERT and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PART 2

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

29 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state

1 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
2 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024 is
3 \$2,250,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be
4 paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

5 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
6 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,
7 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made
8 under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget
9 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

10 Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under
11 section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount
12 appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent
13 resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and
14 serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the
15 particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

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17 **DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE**

18 Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for enforcement of
19 the move over law must be used by the office of highway safety
20 planning in the department of state police for targeted enforcement
21 of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL
22 257.653a. The office of highway safety planning in the department
23 of state police may also use funds appropriated in part 1 for
24 enforcement of the move over law for advertising expenses
25 associated with making the public aware of the requirements of
26 section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL
27 257.653a.

28 (2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for
29 enforcement of the move over law are designated as a work project

1 appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse
 2 at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for
 3 expenditures for projects under this section until the projects
 4 have been completed. The following is in compliance with section
 5 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

6 (a) The purpose of the project is to enforce and make the
 7 public aware of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
 8 300, MCL 257.653a.

9 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state
 10 employees, contracts with service providers, or both.

11 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$2,000,000.00.

12 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2028.

13 (3) Funds appropriated in part 1 for the enforcement of the
 14 move over law must not be spent or otherwise distributed unless
 15 Senate Bill No. 779 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.

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18 **STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

19 Sec. 401. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for signage
 20 regarding the move over law must be used by the state
 21 transportation department, in consultation with the office of
 22 highway safety planning in the department of state police, to put
 23 up road signs that contain information regarding the requirements
 24 of section 653a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL
 25 257.653a.

26 (2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for signage
 27 regarding the move over law are designated as a work project
 28 appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse
 29 at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for

1 expenditures for projects under this section until the projects
2 have been completed. The following is in compliance with section
3 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

4 (a) The purpose of the project is to put up road signs that
5 contain information regarding the requirements of section 653a of
6 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.653a.

7 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state
8 employees, contracts with service providers, or both.

9 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$250,000.00.

10 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2028.

11 (3) Funds appropriated in part 1 for signage regarding the
12 move over law must not be spent or otherwise distributed unless
13 Senate Bill No. 779 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.

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
