

# SENATE BILL NO. 969

July 30, 2024, Introduced by Senator ALBERT and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

A bill to create the immigration and customs enforcement support fund; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

- 1           Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2           (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
- 3           (b) "Enforcement program" means program as that term is
- 4 defined in the immigration and customs enforcement support act.
- 5           (c) "Fund" means the immigration and customs enforcement
- 6 support fund created in section 3.

1 (d) "Law enforcement agency" means that term as defined in the  
2 immigration and customs enforcement support act.

3 (e) "Law enforcement officer" means that term as defined in  
4 the immigration and customs enforcement support act.

5 Sec. 3. (1) The immigration and customs enforcement support  
6 fund is created within the state treasury.

7 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from  
8 any source. The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the  
9 fund. The state treasurer shall credit to the fund interest and  
10 earnings from fund investments.

11 (3) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year must  
12 remain in the fund and not lapse to the general fund.

13 (4) The department is the administrator of the fund for  
14 auditing purposes.

15 Sec. 5. (1) Money in the fund may be used for the  
16 implementation and enforcement of the immigration and customs  
17 enforcement support act, including the administrative costs  
18 associated with implementing the immigration and customs  
19 enforcement support act.

20 (2) By December 31, 2024, the department shall post  
21 instructions for law enforcement agencies to apply for a grant from  
22 the fund. The department shall post the instructions required under  
23 this subsection on a publicly available website.

24 (3) A law enforcement agency may submit an application for a  
25 grant under this section to the department no later than March 15  
26 each year. The department shall make a grant award under this  
27 section no later than May 1 of each year.

28 (4) The department shall comply with all of the following in  
29 awarding a grant under this section:

1           (a) The department shall first award grants sufficient to  
2 allow each law enforcement agency to train 3 law enforcement  
3 officers to participate in an enforcement program or to provide  
4 immigration enforcement assistance through a subsequent program to  
5 an enforcement program.

6           (b) After the department has made awards under subdivision  
7 (a), the department may award a grant to a law enforcement agency  
8 to train additional law enforcement officers. A grant awarded under  
9 this subdivision must be based on the proportion of the population  
10 the law enforcement agency serves compared to the population served  
11 by other law enforcement agencies.

12           (c) After the department has made grant awards under  
13 subdivisions (a) and (b), the department may award a law  
14 enforcement agency an additional grant of not more than \$15,000.00  
15 for each law enforcement officer to provide an incentive to that  
16 law enforcement officer to participate in an enforcement program.

17           Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless  
18 Senate Bill No. 968 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.
