

# SENATE BILL NO. 1081

November 07, 2024, Introduced by Senator SINGH and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 152, entitled "State license fee act," by amending sections 9 and 25 (MCL 338.2209 and 338.2225), section 9 as amended by 1988 PA 461 and section 25 as amended by 2023 PA 131.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 9. The department may charge a fee for the publication  
2 and distribution of the public act ~~from which~~ **that provides** a  
3 board's authority ~~is derived~~ and the rules promulgated under that

4           (2) At the beginning of each state fiscal year, the department  
5 may increase the fees collected under subsection (1) by a  
6 percentage amount equal to not more than the average percentage  
7 wage and salary increase granted for that fiscal year to classified  
8 civil service employees employed by the department.

9           (3) If the department increases fees under subsection (2), the  
10 increase is effective for that fiscal year. The department shall  
11 use the increased fees as the basis for calculating fee increases  
12 in subsequent fiscal years.

13           (4) By August 1 of each year the department shall provide to  
14 the director of the department of management and budget and the  
15 chairpersons of the appropriations committees of the senate and  
16 house of representatives a complete schedule of fees to be  
17 collected under subsection (1) for the following fiscal year.

18           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
19 unless Senate Bill No. 703 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into  
20 law.
