- 3 Whereas, In 1872, the first Arbor Day was established as a
- 4 special day to be set aside for the planting of trees in the
- 5 territory of Nebraska; and
- 6 Whereas, Michigan native J. Sterling Morton championed the
- 7 first Arbor Day in Nebraska; and
- 8 Whereas, In 1885, the Michigan Legislature resolved there will
- 9 be a special day dedicated to the importance of planting trees
- 10 known as Arbor Day; and
- 11 Whereas, Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and

- 1 the world; and
- 2 Whereas, Trees benefit society and the environment by reducing
- 3 the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, cutting
- 4 heating and cooling costs, moderating the temperature, filtering
- 5 the air, producing life-giving oxygen, and providing habitat for
- 6 wildlife; and
- 7 Whereas, Trees are a renewable resource that provide paper,
- 8 fuel, and wood for construction and other wood products; and
- 9 Whereas, Trees in our cities increase property values, enhance
- 10 the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our
- 11 communities; and
- 12 Whereas, Trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy
- 13 and renewal; now, therefore, be it
- 14 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 15 this legislative body declare April 28, 2023, as Arbor Day in the
- 16 state of Michigan.
