- 10 allows parents and guardians to take a more direct role in their

 Whereas, Homeschooling provides an opportunity for
- 3 individualized instruction tailored to the unique needs and
- 4 abilities of each student; and
- 5 Whereas, Homeschooling families contribute significantly to
- 6 the educational landscape of Michigan, fostering a sense of
- 7 community and diversity; now, therefore, be it
- 8 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 9 this legislative body declare October 1-7, 2023, as Homeschool Week
- 10 in the state of Michigan. We recognize the hard work, dedication,
- 11 and commitment of home educator parents and guardians in providing
- 12 quality education to their children and acknowledge the right of
- 13 parents and guardians as outlined in the Michigan Constitution to
- 14 choose homeschooling as a legitimate educational alternative and
- 15 emphasizes the importance of respecting the diversity of
- 16 educational choices available to Michigan families; and be it
