1 A resolution to declare April 28, 2024, as Worker Memorial Day 2 in the state of Michigan.

Whereas, Both federal and Michigan law promises every worker the right to a safe workplace. Michigan's Occupational Safety and

5 Health Act declares that all employees shall be provided safe and6 healthful work environments free of recognized hazards; and

7 Whereas, Still, workplace hazards kill and disable workers

8 each year. U.S. Bureau of Labor statistics estimated that there

9 were 5,486 workplace fatalities in 2022, meaning a worker died

10 every 101 minutes from an occupational injury; and
