- 2 Awareness Day in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Michigan's older adults are valued members of our
- 4 state, and it is our responsibility to ensure their safety and
- 5 minimize crimes against them; and
- 6 Whereas, One in ten older adults in the United States
- 7 experience abuse, neglect and exploitation and crimes against older
- 8 adults often go unnoticed and unreported, leaving victims without
- 9 the help and support they need; and
- 10 Whereas, All Michigan residents should watch for signs of

abuse, such as physical trauma, withdrawal, depression, anxiety and 1 2 fear of family members, friends, or caregivers; efforts to identify, report and investigate elder abuse are critically 3 important in reducing the harm to older adults; and 4 Whereas, To help victims and to prevent more older adults 5 6 from being victimized, we urge Michiganders to learn more about the 7 signs of elder abuse and how to report it; on this day, we join 8 with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Division 9 of Adult Services and the Attorney General to help raise awareness 10 of elder abuse in Michigan; now, therefore, be it 11 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare June 15, 2024, as World Elder Abuse 12

Awareness Day in the state of Michigan.
