HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 207

Reps. Hope, Byrnes, Coffia, Brixie, Morgan, Haadsma, Hood, Wegela, Paiz, Steckloff, MacDonell, Wilson and Aiyash offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare March 10-16, 2024, as Sunshine Week in 2 the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Sunshine Week is a national initiative spearheaded by
- 4 the American Society of News Editors to educate the public about
- 5 the importance of open government and the dangers of excessive and
- 6 unnecessary secrecy. The first nationwide Sunshine Week took place
- 7 March 13-19, 2005; and
- 8 Whereas, Sunshine Week was established to spark a discussion
- 9 about the importance of open government and public access to
- 10 government documents and meetings. Sunshine Week was also a way to

- ${f 1}$ draw attention to the media's role in advocating for government
- 2 transparency; and
- 3 Whereas, The American public has relied on a free press for
- 4 more than two centuries to stay informed about the many activities
- 5 in which our government engages. Thomas Jefferson penned in his
- 6 letter to Elbridge Gerry on January 26, 1799, that "I am ... for
- 7 freedom of the press, and against all violations of the
- 8 Constitution to silence by force and not by reason the complaints
- 9 or criticisms, just or unjust, of our citizens against the conduct
- 10 of their agents." Six U.S. Supreme Court justices ruled in favor of
- 11 the Freedom of the Press in New York Times Co. v. United States,
- 12 with Justice Black concurring, "Only a free and unrestrained press
- 13 can effectively expose deception in government;" and
- 14 Whereas, Without the diligent work of a free press, many
- 15 Americans would not have access to accurate information that
- 16 directly impacts their daily lives. Many institutions promoting a
- 17 free press have been targeted by high profile and unwarranted
- 18 attacks discrediting their viability through a new era of
- 19 misinformation; and
- 20 Whereas, An open and accessible government is vital to
- 21 establishing and maintaining the people's trust and confidence in
- 22 their government and in the government's ability to effectively
- 23 serve its citizens and free press is an essential part of that
- 24 mission; now, therefore, be it
- 25 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 26 this legislative body declare March 10-16, 2024, as Sunshine Week
- 27 in the state of Michigan. We recognize every citizen in our
- 28 participatory democracy has an inherent right to access to
- 29 government meetings and public records and is committed to openness

- 1 and transparency in all aspects of its operations and seeks to set
- 2 a standard in this regard.
