## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.254

Reps. Thompson, Mueller, Alexander, St. Germaine, Hall, Bierlein and VanderWall offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare May 7-13, 2024, as Fentanyl Awareness

2 Week in the state of Michigan.

**3** Whereas, Fentanyl is a powerful synthetic opioid that is 50 to

f 4 100 times more potent than morphine, and 30 to 50 times more potent

5 than heroin. Just two milligrams—the equivalent of a few grains of

6 salt—is a potentially lethal dose; and

7 Whereas, Fentanyl has been increasingly found mixed with other

drugs, such as heroin, cocaine, and counterfeit pills, contributing

9 to the current opioid crisis; and

10 Whereas, Most recent cases of fentanyl-related overdose are

11 linked to illicitly manufactured fentanyl, which is distributed

- 1 through illegal drug markets for its heroin-like effect. It is
- 2 often added to other drugs because of its extreme potency, which
- 3 makes drugs cheaper, more powerful, more addictive, and more
- 4 dangerous; and
- 5 Whereas, The Sinaloa and Jalisco cartels are hiding fentanyl
- 6 in fake pills that look like prescription medications, such as
- 7 oxycodone, Xanax, and Percocet. The cartels are also mixing
- 8 fentanyl powder into other drugs, including cocaine, heroin, and
- 9 methamphetamine. Many of the people poisoned by fentanyl had no
- 10 idea they were even taking it; and
- 11 Whereas, The cartels, their members, and their associates
- 12 continue using social media applications and encrypted
- 13 communications platforms to sell pills and powders that are
- 14 advertised as legitimate medications or other substances, but
- 15 actually contain fentanyl; and
- 16 Whereas, The Detroit Field Division of the Drug Enforcement
- 17 Administration confiscated 1,168 pounds of fentanyl in 2023, 70%
- 18 more than it seized the previous year, according to a statement
- 19 from federal authorities; and
- 20 Whereas, Fentanyl has been a significant contributor to the
- 21 rise in drug overdose deaths in the State of Michigan and across
- 22 the United States; and
- 23 Whereas, Fentanyl-related deaths in Michigan have surged
- 24 dramatically in recent years, there were 2,539 opioid overdose
- 25 deaths recorded in Michigan in 2021; and
- 26 Whereas, The impact of fentanyl on communities in Michigan has
- 27 been profound, affecting individuals, families, and neighborhoods
- 28 across the state; and
- 29 Whereas, Raising awareness about the dangers of fentanyl is

- 1 crucial to combating its spread and preventing further loss of
- 2 lives; now, therefore, be it
- 3 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 4 this legislative body declare May 7-13, 2024, as Fentanyl Awareness
- 5 Week in the State of Michigan. We call this observance to the
- 6 attention of all our citizens.
