- 3 Whereas, The Supreme Court of the United States issued its
- 4 landmark decision in JANUS v. AFSCME on June 27, 2018, affirming
- 5 the constitutional rights of public sector employees regarding
- 6 union membership and dues; and
- 7 Whereas, The principles of free speech and freedom of
- 8 association guaranteed by the First Amendment ensure that public
- 9 sector employees have the right to make decisions that are in their
- 10 best interest; and
- 11 Whereas, Freedom in decision making empowers public sector
- 12 workers by granting them the ability to make individual choices

regarding their representation, fostering a climate of transparency 1 2 and accountability within public sector unions; and Whereas, Safeguarding employee choices in representation 3 protects jobs and has contributed to a more equitable workplace 4 environment by safeguarding the rights of dissenting employees and 5 6 protecting their freedom from compelled political speech; and 7 Whereas, Michigan had the foresight to ensure workplace 8 freedom for public sector employees six years before the JANUS decision, further demonstrating Michigan's unwavering dedication to 9 10 the principles of fairness and competition in employment; and 11 Whereas, The principles articulated in the JANUS decision continue to resonate as a cornerstone of constitutional 12 jurisprudence, serving as a bulwark against coercion and ensuring 13 the protection of individual liberties; and 14 15 Whereas, June 27th marks the sixth anniversary of the JANUS court decision as it continues to have a profound impact on 16 safeguarding the constitutional rights of public sector employees 17 across the United States; now, therefore, be it 18 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 19

this legislative body declare June 27, 2024, as Public Employee

Freedom Day in the state of Michigan.
