SUMMARY:

House Bill 4486 would create a new act to prohibit the governing body of a county, city, village, or township from adopting or enforcing an ordinance, resolution, or policy that prohibits the use of natural gas, or the installation of infrastructure to transport or distribute natural gas, in that municipality. Such an ordinance, resolution, or policy adopted on or after the date the bill takes effect would be void and unenforceable.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 4486 would have no fiscal impact on any units of state or local government.
