April 16, 2025, Introduced by Reps. B. Carter, McKinney, Weiss, Xiong, Rheingans, Byrnes, Breen, McFall, Wegela, Edwards, Tsernoglou, Hoskins, Conlin, O'Neal, Longjohn, Price, MacDonell and Andrews and referred to Committee on Economic Competitiveness.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967,"

by amending section 471 (MCL 206.471), as amended by 2023 PA 100, and by adding section 707a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 471. (1) The department shall administer the tax imposed
- 2 by this part. The department shall prescribe forms for use by
- 3 taxpayers and may promulgate rules for all of the following:

- (a) The maintenance by taxpayers of records, books, and
 accounts.
- 3 (b) The computation of the tax.
- 4 (c) The manner and time of changing or electing accounting
 5 methods and of exercising the accounting method options contained
 6 in this part.
- 7 (d) The making of returns, the payment of tax due, and the 8 ascertainment, assessment, and collection of the tax.
- 9 (2) The rules shall must follow the rulings of the United
 10 States Internal Revenue Service with respect to the federal income
 11 tax if those rulings are not inconsistent with this part, and the
 12 department may adopt as a part of the rules any portions of the
 13 internal revenue code or rulings, in whole or in part.
- 14 (3) Each state income tax return shall must contain a space 15 for the taxpayer to indicate the school district in which the 16 taxpayer resides. Beginning with the 2023 tax year and each tax 17 year after 2023, the state income tax return shall must contain a 18 space for the individual taxpayer to indicate if the individual taxpayer is willing to participate in the anatomical gift donor 19 20 registry under part 101 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 21 333.10101 to 333.10123. The state income tax return shall must also 22 include the following statement under that space: "An individual 23 taxpayer willing to participate in the anatomical gift donor 24 registry must complete the donor registry schedule and submit it 25 with the taxpayer's state income tax return.".
- 26 (4) The department may provide information in the instruction 27 booklet about the purchase of an annual state park motor vehicle 28 permit pursuant to part 741 of the natural resources and 29 environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.74101 to

- 2 (5) In the instruction booklet that accompanies the annual
- 3 return required under this part, the department shall include all
- 4 of the following:
- 5 (a) A clear and concise listing of each credit and each
- 6 deduction allowed under this part and a reference to a detailed
- 7 explanation.
- 8 (b) A summary of state expenditures and revenues by major
- 9 category, in dollar amounts and percentage of total, for the most
- 10 recent state fiscal year that the information is available.
- 11 (c) Beginning with the 2023 tax year, information describing
- 12 the donor registry program maintained by Michigan's federally
- 13 designated organ procurement organization or its successor
- 14 organization under section 10120 of the public health code, 1978 PA
- 15 368, MCL 333.10120, explaining the taxpayer's right to make an
- 16 anatomical gift in the event of death under part 101 of the public
- 17 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10123, and providing
- 18 the taxpayer with the opportunity to specify, in a form and manner
- 19 as prescribed by the department under section 474, on the
- 20 taxpayer's annual return required under this part that the
- 21 individual taxpayer is willing to participate in the anatomical
- 22 gift donor registry under part 101 of the public health code, 1978
- 23 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10123.
- 24 (d) Beginning with the instruction booklet for the 2025 tax
- 25 year and each tax year after 2025, a page explaining the rules and
- 26 factors considered for classifying an individual as an employee or
- 27 an independent contractor. The page must also include the contact
- 28 information for both the Michigan department of labor and economic
- 29 opportunity's wage and hour division and the Michigan department of

- 1 attorney general for the purposes of reporting payroll fraud if the
- 2 individual believes that the individual has been misclassified as
- 3 an independent contractor.
- 4 (6) The department shall post the list described in subsection
- 5 (5) (a) and the page described in subsection (5) (d) on the
- 6 department's official website.
- 7 Sec. 707a. Beginning after the effective date of this section,
- 8 the department shall send a notice to each payee listed on the copy
- 9 of each form 1099-MISC that was filed with the department under
- 10 section 707 that explains the rules and factors considered for
- 11 classifying an individual as an employee or an independent
- 12 contractor. The notice must also include the contact information
- 13 for both the Michigan department of labor and economic
- 14 opportunity's wage and hour division and the Michigan department of
- 15 attorney general for the purposes of reporting payroll fraud if the
- 16 individual believes that the individual has been misclassified as
- 17 an independent contractor.
