April 16, 2025, Introduced by Reps. O'Neal, McKinney, Weiss, Xiong, Rheingans, Byrnes, Breen, McFall, Wegela, B. Carter, Tsernoglou, Hoskins, Conlin, Longjohn, Price, MacDonell and Andrews and referred to Committee on Economic Competitiveness.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025 is \$5,000,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL

Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for payroll fraud enforcement unit must be used to hire approximately 25 FTEs to investigate and prosecute cases, including payroll fraud cases.

(2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for payroll fraud enforcement unit are designated as a work project

1 appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse
2 at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for
3 expenditures for the project under this section until the project
4 has been completed. The following is in compliance with section
5 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

6 (a) The purpose of the project is to hire approximately 25
7 FTEs to investigate and prosecute cases, including payroll fraud
8 cases.

9 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state
10 employees.

11 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$5,000,000.00.

12 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2029.

13 (3) As used in this section, "FTEs" means full-time equated
14 employees.
