A bill to amend 1897 PA 180, entitled

"An act to provide for the issuance of marriage licenses and certificates without publicity in certain cases; and to provide criminal and civil penalties for violation of this act,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 551.201), as amended by 2023 PA 122.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) When an individual desires to keep the exact date
- 2 of his or her the individual's marriage to an another individual of
- 3 the opposite sex a secret, the probate judge may issue, without

- publicity, a marriage license to any individual making application,
 under oath, if there is good reason expressed in the application
 and determined to be sufficient by the probate judge.
- 4 (2) The probate judge may authorize an order nunc pro tunc 5 regarding the date to appear on the marriage license.
- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect 7 unless Senate Joint Resolution (request no. S00781'25) or
- 8 House Joint Resolution F (request no. H00781'25) of the 103rd
- 9 Legislature becomes a part of the state constitution of 1963 as
- 10 provided in section 1 of article XII of the state constitution of
