

HOUSE BILL NO. 4680

June 25, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Woolford, Kunse, Schuette, Robinson, DeBoyer and Meerman
and referred to Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 396 (MCL 750.396), as amended by 2002 PA 672.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 396. (1) ~~A person~~**An individual** who intentionally
2 conceals ~~his or her~~**the individual's** identity by wearing a mask or
3 other device covering ~~his or her~~**the individual's** face for the
4 purpose of facilitating the commission of a crime is guilty of a
5 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 93 days,
6 ~~or~~**a** fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.

1 (2) If an individual is wearing a mask or other device
2 covering the individual's face and either of the following applies,
3 a law enforcement officer may stop the individual and request the
4 individual to remove the mask or other device and provide
5 identification or otherwise provide the individual's identity:

6 (a) An individual is wearing a mask or other device covering
7 the individual's face for the purpose of concealing the
8 individual's identity with the intent to threaten, intimidate,
9 injure, or oppress another individual or group of individuals.

10 (b) An individual is wearing a mask or other device covering
11 the individual's face while violating a law of this state or a
12 local ordinance.

13 (3) An individual who refuses to comply with a law enforcement
14 officer's request under subsection (2) is guilty of a misdemeanor
15 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year, a fine of not
16 more than \$2,500.00, or both.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
18 after the date it is enacted into law.
