

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4791

August 21, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Steckloff, Pavlov, Thompson, Wozniak, Schmaltz and Bruck and referred to Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled  
"Public health code,"  
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 9135.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 9135. (1) The department, in consultation with qualified  
2 organizations, shall develop or adopt and implement a menopause  
3 transition awareness education program. The education program must  
4 include information on all of the following:

5       (a) The symptoms and trajectories of change from menopausal  
6 transition to post-menopause transition.

1 (b) Chronic conditions related to menopause.

2 (c) The range of treatment options that may be prescribed by a  
3 health professional for symptoms, changes, and conditions, and  
4 available tools to screen individuals for menopause.

5 (d) Any other information that the department considers  
6 necessary or appropriate to educate the public and health  
7 professionals on menopause and chronic conditions related to  
8 menopause.

9 (2) The department shall disseminate the information described  
10 in this section and promote the educational program to health  
11 professionals and the public. The department may post the  
12 information on the department's website.

13 (3) As used in this section:

14 (a) "Educational program" means the menopause transition  
15 awareness education program developed or adopted under subsection  
16 (1).

17 (b) "Qualified organizations" means the Michigan board of  
18 medicine created in part 170, the Michigan board of osteopathic  
19 medicine and surgery created in part 175, and organizations that  
20 promote the health of women during menopause.
