

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 52

Reps. Edwards, Foreman, Young, McFall, MacDonell, Breen, Dievendorf, Morgan, Paiz, Rheingans, Weiss and Witwer offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare March 2025 as National Social Work
2 Month in the state of Michigan.

3 Whereas, The social work profession for decades has been
4 dedicated to improving human well-being and enhancing the basic
5 needs of all people, especially the most vulnerable among us; and

6 Whereas, This year's Social Work Month theme, "Social Work:
7 Compassion & Action", embodies the spirit of the profession's
8 challenge to structure that cause hardships for everyday people,
9 and honors the labor of social workers in progressing forward
10 movements; and

11 Whereas, Social workers have always been present in times of
12 crisis, helping people overcome issues such as death and grief and

1 helping people and communities recover from natural disasters such
2 as fires, hurricanes, and earthquakes; and

3 Whereas, Social workers have helped this nation live up to its
4 values by successfully advocating for equal rights for all people;
5 and

6 Whereas, School social workers have worked with families and
7 schools throughout the pandemic to ensure students reach their full
8 academic and personal potential; and

9 Whereas, Social workers work in all parts of our society to
10 empower people to live to their fullest potential; and

11 Whereas, Social workers play a crucial role in our nation's
12 health care system and have played a key role in this nation's
13 response to COVID-19 and helping individuals, families, and
14 communities cope with the epidemic; and

15 Whereas, Social workers are one of the largest groups of
16 mental health care providers in the United States and work daily to
17 help people, whether in person or remotely, overcome substance use
18 disorders and mental illnesses such as depression and anxiety; and

19 Whereas, The social work profession is one of the fastest
20 growing professions in the United States, with nearly 800,000
21 people expected to be employed as social workers by 2029; and

22 Whereas, Social workers will continue to stand ready to assist
23 our nation in overcoming present and future challenges; now,
24 therefore, be it

25 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
26 this legislative body declare March 2025 as National Social Work
27 Month in the state of Michigan.
