- 4 serves as a global call to action to promote environmental

- 6 Whereas, The first Earth Day in 1970 united millions of
- 7 Americans across the country in the effort to raise awareness of
- 8 environmental issues; and
- 9 Whereas, The state of Michigan is home to a rich and diverse
- 10 natural heritage, including the Great Lakes the largest system of
- 11 fresh surface water in the world as well as vast forests, rivers,
- 12 wetlands, agricultural lands, and wildlife habitats that provide
- 13 essential resources, recreation, and economic benefits for all

- Whereas, Michigan's residents, businesses, schools, and local
- 3 governments have demonstrated leadership in promoting recycling,
- 4 protecting water quality, and supporting conservation practices to
- 5 ensure that Michigan's natural resources are preserved for current

- 7 Whereas, Earth Day 2025 provides an opportunity to recommit to
- 8 the protection and preservation of Michigan's environment,
- 9 recognizing that the health of our communities, economy, and future
- 10 depends on clean air, safe drinking water, resilient ecosystems,
- 11 and sustainable development; and
- 12 Whereas, The Michigan House of Representatives encourages all
- 13 Michiganders to engage in Earth Day activities such as tree
- 14 planting, waterway cleanups, waste reduction, energy conservation,
- 15 and participation in community sustainability initiatives; now,
- 16 therefore, be it
- 17 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 18 this legislative body declare April 22, 2025, as Earth Day in the
- 19 state of Michigan. We encourage all residents to reflect on the
- 20 importance of environmental stewardship to protect Michigan's
- 21 natural resources and build a more sustainable future for all.
